Distance education over the world (τεκcτ)

Distance education has had a history of more than 100 years. But it gained popularity only after 1970's. Many countries like China, England, Japan, Russia, Spain and the USA use this method especially in higher education.

For example, the Open University in England has more than 80,000 students who take about 140 courses per year. This University has 260 local teaching and 13 regional information center.

Such factors as age, place, and daily activity do not serve as limiting factors in distance education. Distance education has two main advantages over traditional classroom education. The first advantages is a solution to the problem of teaching staff shortage and the second one is the low cost of education which gives many people and opportunity to receive higher education.

This education allows each student to have an individual scheme of study.
