### **Famous British Cities**

A. Glasgow is Scotland's most populous city and third largest in the British Isles. As a seaport it enjoyed a favourable position for trade with North America. Engineering did not decline as much as coalmining and shipbuilding. Textile and clothing production continue to be important and carpets are among the woolen goods.

B. Birmingham is the second largest city in Britain with a population of about one million. It has been said that Birmingham makes everything from a pin to a steam roller. The city has preserved its long traditions of making guns, especially sporting guns. Also famous are articles in gold and silver.

C. The other major city is Coventry which is the centre of the British motor industry. Heavy engineering and tyre production are highly developed here.

D. Liverpool grew from a small fishing village to become Britain's leading port in the 19th century. Today the city and its industry are in a difficult position. The chemical industry developed here based on the salt deposits nearby.

E. In the past Manchester was a major centre of the textile industry. The Industrial Revolution started here. The building of canals contributed to the development of the city and especially the Manchester ship canal which made the city a seaport though it is 50 km from the sea.

F. On the basis of local ore the iron and steel industry developed in Scunthorpe. The city has large integrated steelworks where all the stages of steel manufacture take place. Scunthorpe has become one of the leading steel making centres in the country.

G. Milford Haven which is situated in the very south-west of the country is the main port of Wales today. It is one of the leading oil terminals of Britain and an important oil refining centre.

H. Edinburgh is the capital of Scotland though it is smaller in size than Glasgow. It is often called «The Athens of the North» because of its beauty and lots of tourists visit the city. It's a number of important industries, including textile manufacture.. It is also a university city that is why paper manufacture, publishing and printing are important here.
